We are looking for a STEM Technician to join our team at Falmouth School. The STEM Technician will work closely with staff to support, develop and further extend the work of the department and the experiences of the students.

The post-holder will contribute to a positive work environment by keeping it well maintained, supporting the team by providing resources and ensuring all practical requirements are met. They will be able to demonstrate excellent organisational skills, and will have a passion for science, design technology and education. Typical duties include preparing necessary solutions and equipment for practical experiments as well as maintaining, repairing and taking inventory of apparatus. You will also liaise with the staff in the science and design technology departments over equipment and safety issues and run trials of experiments and demonstrations.

Training will be provided to help develop the full range of skills to carry out this role effectively. This is a key role in the success of the science and design technology departments and the technician role forms a central part of the work of the departments.

If you are totally reliable, have excellent time keeping skills and are adept at managing competing priorities we would welcome an application. This role requires the ability to maintain confidentiality. You will undertake a wide range of tasks and must be approachable and sensitive to the needs of all students, as well as being a team player who takes an interest in the range of work undertaken by the school and Trust and be happy to be part of a highly successful Trust.
