This week we have been doing “Owl Baby” activities. We enjoyed listening to the story and making owls.

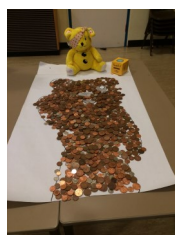


School Council

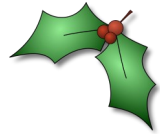
